

BENTO BAG

Sewing Pattern+ Tutorial



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YOU WILL NEED

- Approx. 1m (1yd) fabric - medium weight linen or cotton are best

57cm x 57cm
(22½" x 22½")

Cut 1 x square
and 2 x straps

5cm x 61cm (2" x 24")



1. CUT FABRIC

Cut 1 square measuring 57cm x 57cm (22½" x 22½"). You'll also need to cut 2 straps measuring 5cm x 61cm (2" x 24") each.

2. SEW EDGE + CORNERS

Fold each edge by 1cm (¾") and press. Make a mitred corner if you can (search Google for mitred corners for great tutorials). Stitch all edges and corners.

3. PRESS STRAPS

Press shorter edges of straps by 1cm (¾"). Fold straps in half lengthways and press again.

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4. STITCH STRAPS

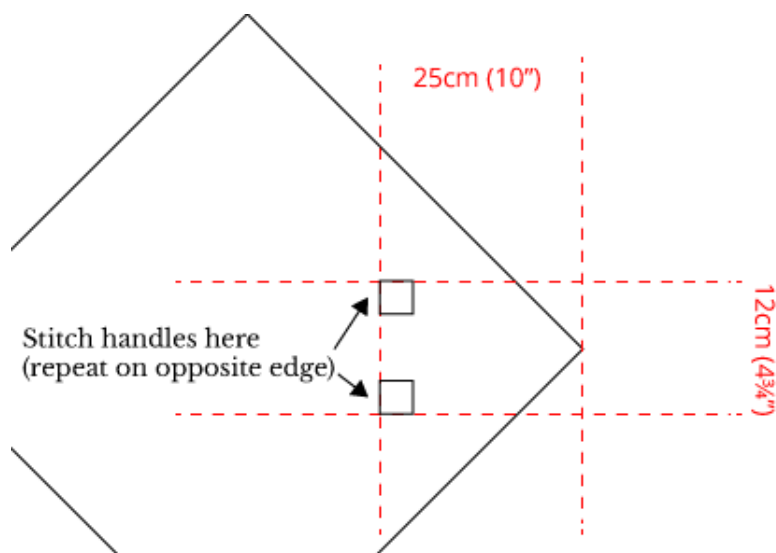
Stitch along the long edge of each strap, close to the raw edge.

5. FINISH STRAPS

Turn straps to the right side. Topstitch along all edges. Press.

6. ATTACH STRAPS

Pin straps into place (see below diagram for placement). Stitch a square about 2cm x 2cm (45" x 45") to attach on to bag.
